Grassroots Groundwater: A Field Course

Overall Theme:

Hands-on Field Course for grade 8 students to pump wells and gather data. Measure water levels in drilled well and monitoring well at specified times after pump start-up (calculate difference between static and pumping conditions). Calculate water table elevation in wells from surveyed point. Use Wattera pump to pump water from monitoring well.
